Chamber Orchestra Audition Requirements 2023–2024

Who is required to audition?

- 1. New students in rhetoric who are attending Geneva 2023–2024
- 2. 6th–8th graders with prior experience with a minimum of 2 years who can play on a performance based level
- 3. Returning rhetoric students who have not previously been in orchestra
- 4. Homeschooled students 6th–12th grade who can play on a performance-based level

When and where is the audition?

1. August 22, 2023, in the lower school instrumental room (room 130)

Requirements

- 1. 3 Major Scales
 - a. Any 3 of the following scales will be called to be played:
 - i. Violin: D, A, G, E, C, F, Bb, Eb, **a***, **d***, **g***
 - ii. Viola: C, A, G, D, Eb, F, Ab, **d***, **g***, **c***
 - iii. Violoncello: C, A, G, D, Eb, F, Ab, d*, g*, c*
 - iv. Double Bass: G, D, A, F, Eb, C, Bb, e*, g*, a*
 - v. Piano: All twelve major scales, natural minor, melodic minor
 - b. One scale will be performed two octaves. Pianist must play two octaves.
 - C. Scales will be performed in the 2023–2024 Florida All-State pattern at or above 60bpm. The Florida All-State pattern is in **straight eighth notes**, ascending and descending.
- * Lowercase letters indicate a <u>minor scale</u>. You may perform them as natural minor or melodic minor. 11th–12th graders who are intending to audition for All-State should perform melodic minor scales.
 - 2. Solo
 - a. Prepare 1 ½ –2 minutes of a solo piece of your choice. Materials can be pulled from etude, lessons, or other appropriate solo books. Be sure that it exemplifies the best of your playing skills.
 - 3. Sight Reading
 - b. Students will be provided one minute to read over one line of music. Be sure to pay attention to STARS (sharps and flats, time signatures, accidentals, rhythms, and signs/roadmap).
 - c. After the minute is up, students will be expected to play through the portion with no stops or repeats to the best of their ability.
 - 4. Brief Check-in
 - d. Please take this time with me to communicate your aspirations/goals so that I can assist you best this school year. Things to discuss can be:
 - i. Private lessons & teachers
 - ii. All-State and HPS requirements
 - iii. Musical challenges and desired techniques
 - iv. Performance opportunities
